

pelvic irrigation treatment was proved effective. By this method of surgery, chyluria could be cured without exception in all the cases, and this has been made clear as it was found that the route of chylic lymph flowing into and to mingle with the urinal tract was *via* renal pedicle lymphatics. Fig. 5 shows the feature of pyelo-lymphatic extravasation by retrograde pyelography, while no extravasation can be seen, as obvious in fig. 6, after the surgery.
